Dr. Rubén García García, Project and Activity Director, welcomed participants along with Dr. Margarita Irizarry Ramírez, Activity Co-Director, who shared with the audience her experience as an established Clinical and Translational researcher who did not have the opportunity to prospectively train in her field within an entrepreneurial framework.
